

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

STEP 1

Install (2) Pedals onto the step bars with (12) M8X1.25-25mm Hex Bolts, (12) M8 Large Flat Washers and (12) M8 Lock Washers.

IMPORTANT: Don't punch the pedal with any metal hummer within pedal installation, or the pedal will be damaged.




STEP 2


Start installation from the passenger front side of the vehicle. Determine if the vehicle has an open floor panel or a threaded hole in the floor panel:

A. Vehicles with open mounting location:




(Fig 2) Line up Nut Plate with hole located between the (2) holes on the pinch weld

- **a.** Insert (1) M8X1.25 Nut Plate into the large square opening in the floor panel. Line up the threaded nut with the hole located between the pair of holes on the pinch weld, **(Fig 1A, 1B & 2)**.
- b. Move to the Passenger Side Rear Mounting Location, (Fig
 3). Repeat Step 2a to insert the M8X1.25 Nut Plate into the rear opening on the floor panel.



(Fig 1A) Passenger Side Front Mounting Location (Vehicles with open mounting location)

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
(Fig 4) Passenger Side Front Mounting Location (Vehicles with factory threaded hole in floor panel)

B. Vehicles with factory threaded hole in floor panel: Locate the passenger side front and rear mounting locations, (Figs 4 & 5). Continue to Step 3.

STEP 3


Assemble Passenger Front Mounting Bracket (**PFM**) and Passenger Front Support Bracket (**PFS**) as shown, (**Fig 6**). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.



(Fig 6) Passenger Front Mounting Bracket Assembly


STEP 4

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


(Fig 8) Passenger Front Support Bracket Installed

Attach the Passenger Front Support Bracket on the <u>back</u> of the pinch weld. Secure to the (2) pairs of holes on the pinch weld with (2) M6X1-25 Hex Bolts, (4) M6 Large Flat Washers & (2) M6X1 Nylon Lock Nuts (Figs 7 & 8). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.



(Fig 7) Passenger Front Support Bracket Installation

STEP 5

Vehicles with open mounting location:




(Fig 9) Passenger Front Mounting Bracket Installed (Vehicles with open mounting location)

Bolt the Passenger Front Mounting Brackets to the M8X1.25 Nut Plate with (1) M8X1.25-35 Hex Bolt, (1) M8 Lock Washer and (1) M8 Large Flat Washer. (Fig 9). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.


STEP 6

Vehicles with factory threaded hole in floor panel:




(Fig 11) Passenger Front Mounting Bracket Installed (Vehicles with factory threaded hole in floor panel)

Bolt the Mounting Bracket to the threaded holes in the floor panel with (1) M8X1.25-35 Hex Bolt, (1) M8 Large Flat Washer, (1) M8 Lock Washer (Figs 10 & 11). Do not fully tighten hardware.



(Fig 10) Passenger Front Mounting Bracket Installed (Vehicles with factory threaded hole in floor panel)

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STEP 7




(Fig 12) Passenger Rear Mounting Bracket Assembly

Assemble Passenger Rear Mounting Bracket (PRM) and Passenger Rear Support Brackets (PRS1 & PRS2) (Fig 12). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

STEP 8


Install the Assembled Passenger Rear Mounting Bracket onto the vehicle, (Figs 13-16).

(Fig 14) Passenger Rear Mounting Bracket Installation (Vehicles with factory threaded hole in floor panel)




(Fig 15) Passenger Rear Mounting Bracket Installation (Vehicles with open mounting location)

STEP 9


Once all (2) brackets have been installed, select (3) M8X1.25-20mm T-Bolts, thread (1) M8 Plastic Washer on each T-Bolt, (**Fig 16**). Install the (3) M8X1.25-20mm T-Bolts with plastic washers in the slots on the assembled step bar. Rotate the T-Bolts to 90 degree, thread down the M8 Plastic Washers against the step bar (**Fig 17**).

<u>NOTE:</u> The Plastic Washer is designed to keep the T-Bolt in place to avoid falling into the tube during installation.

STEP 10

Attach the Assembled Passenger Side Step Bar onto the Mounting Brackets with (3) M8 Plastic Washers, (3) M8X1.25-20mm T-Bolts, (3) M8 Flat Washers, (3) M8 Nylon Lock Nuts, (**Fig 18**). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

NOTE: the Passenger Rear Mounting Bracket is located under the pedal. Slide (1) M6X1-20mm Square Head Bolt into the channel at the bottom of pedal (**Fig 19**). And secure the Rear Mounting Bracket to the pedal with (1) M6 Large Flat Washer and (1) M6 Nylon Lock Nut, **(Fig 18)**. Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

STEP 11

Level and adjust the assembled Step Bar properly and tighten all hardware.

Move to the other side of the vehicle. Repeat **Steps 2-10** for the other Side Step Bar installation.

Attention

Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

In order to protect your bars/boards, please use mild soap/non-abrasive products for cleaning only.

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
