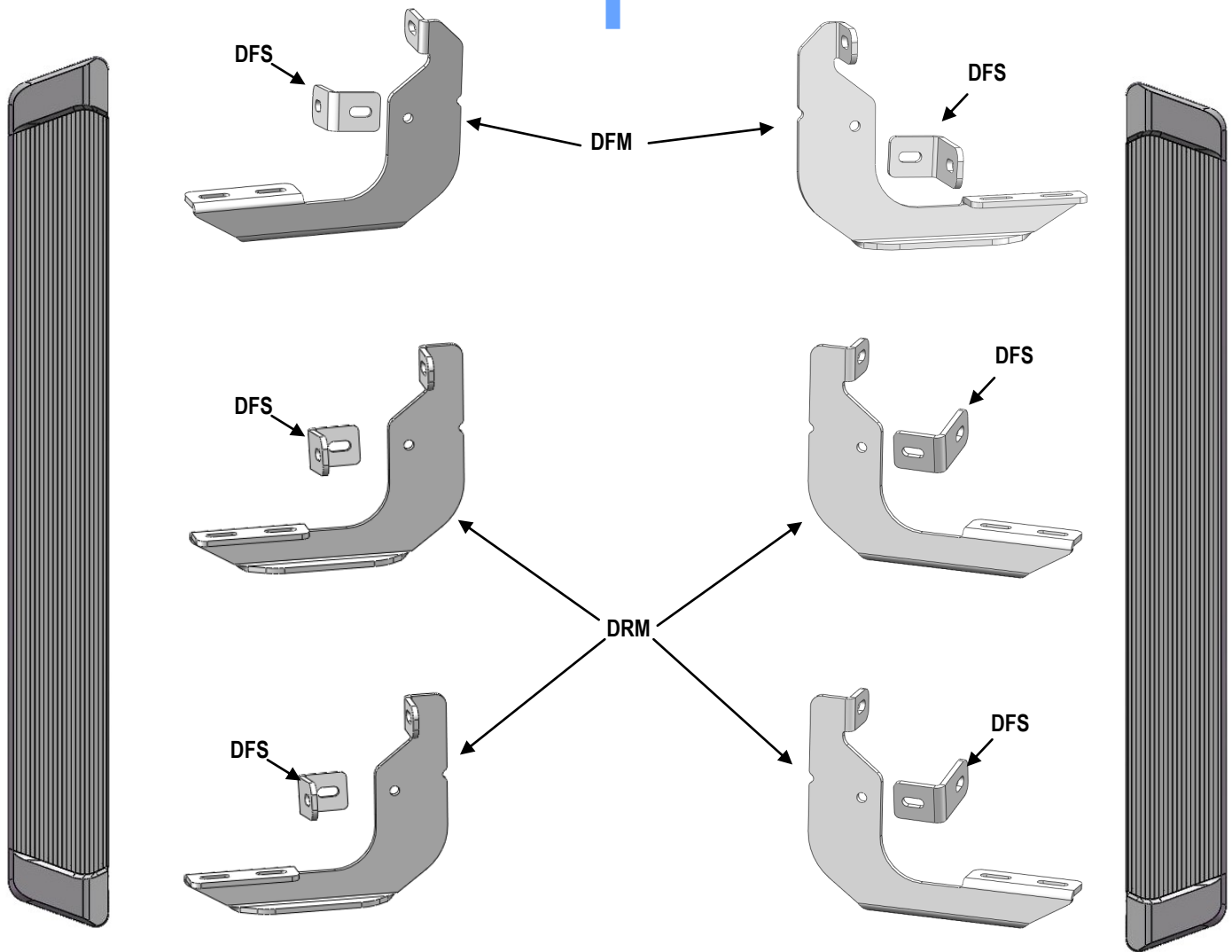

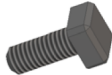

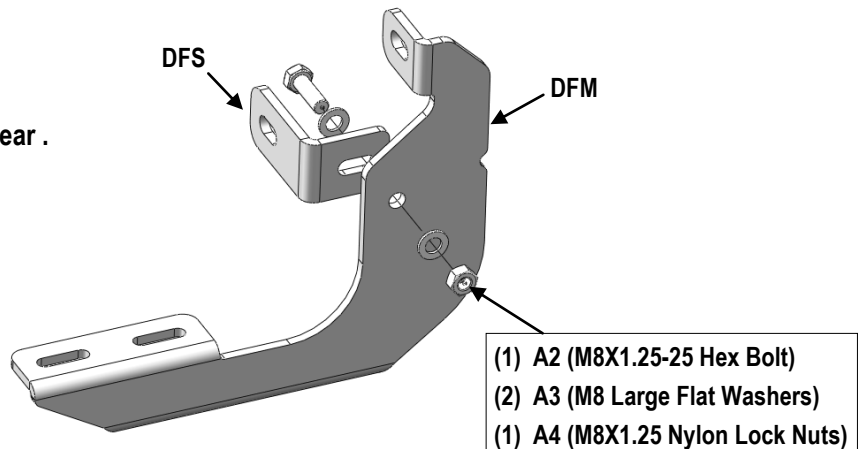


STEP 1: Assemble Passenger Side Mounting Brackets

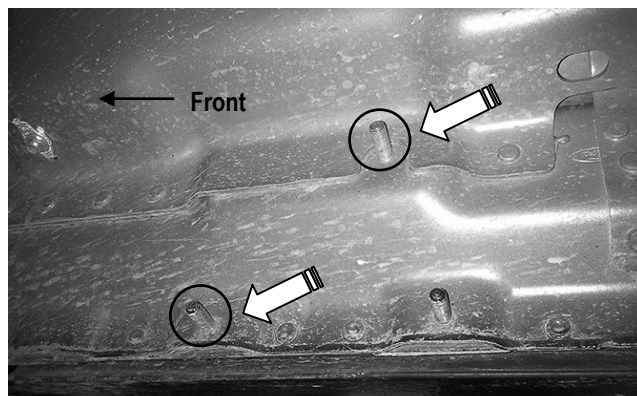


(Fig1):Passenger Front Mounting Brackets Assembly (DFM +DFS)

Assemble Driver Front Mounting Bracket (DFM) and Driver Front Support Bracket (DFS) (Fig 1) with:

- (1) A2 (M8X1.25-25 Hex Bolt)
- (2) A3 (M8 Large Flat Washers)
- (1) A4 (M8X1.25 Nylon Lock Nuts)

Repeat to assemble (2) Mounting Brackets (DCM+DFS) for Passenger side Center and Rear .

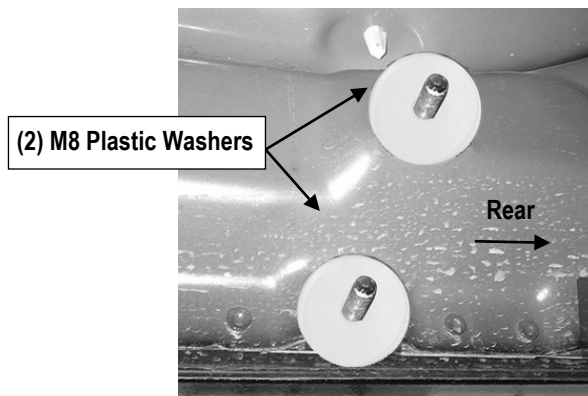
STEP 2: Install Passenger Front Mounting Brackets

- (1) Locate the Passenger Side Front Mounting Location along the inner side of the body panel, (Fig 2).
- (2) Thread (1) M8 Plastic Washer over each of the (2) factory mounting studs on the body panel, (Fig 3).

Note: The M8 Plastic Washers are designed to prevent corrosion between the aluminum body panel and the steel Mounting Brackets.

(Fig 3) M8 Plastic Washers Installed



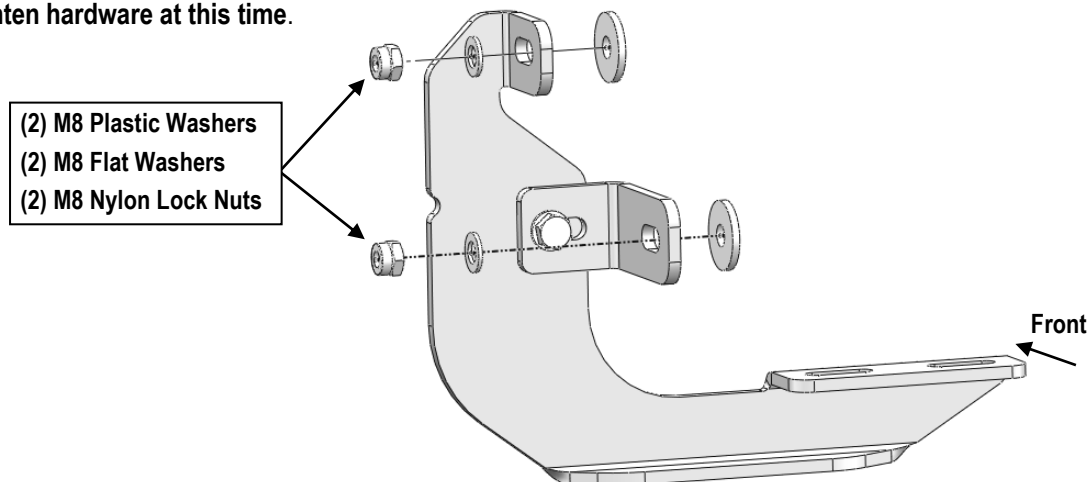
STEP 3: Install Passenger Front Mounting Brackets

Attach the Assembled Passenger Front Mounting Bracket (**DFM+DFS**) to the (2) factory studs (**Fig 4**). with:

(2) A3 (M8 Large Flat Washers)

(2) A4 (M8 Nylon Lock Nuts)

NOTE: Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

STEP 4: Install The Passenger Center & Rear Mounting Brackets

Move to the Passenger Side Center & Rear Locations of the vehicle.

Repeat **Step 3** to install the assembled Passenger Center and Rear Mounting Brackets (**DRM+DFS**)

STEP 5: Passenger Side Step Bar Installation

Once all (3) mounting brackets are installed, then proceed to the Running Board installation.

(1) Select a Running Board. Slide (3) B1 M6X1-20mm Square Head Bolts into each bottom channel (**Fig 5**).

(2) Carefully position the Running Board onto the (3) Mounting Brackets.

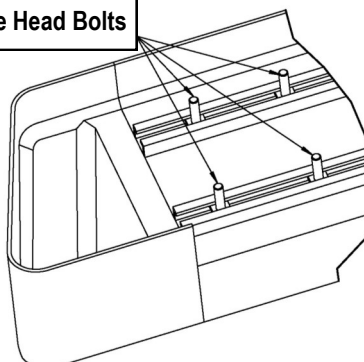
(3) Attach the Running Board to each Mounting Bracket (**Fig 6**) with

- (2) B1 M6X1-20mm Square Head Bolts
- (2) B2 M6 Large Flat Washers and
- (2) B3 M6 Nylon Lock Nuts

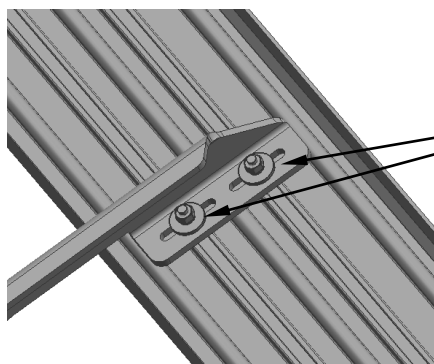
Note: Do not slide the Running Board on the Brackets or the bottom surface of the board will be damaged.

(Fig 5) Slip M6X1-20mm Square Head Bolts Into The Bottom Channels



(2) B1 (M6X1-20mm Square Head Bolts)
(2) B2 (M6 Large Flat Washers)
(2) B3 (M6 Nylon Lock Nuts)

(Fig 6) Running Board Installed Onto Mounting Bracket

STEP 6: Passenger Side Step Bar Adjustment

- Level and adjust the assembled Step Bar properly.
- Tighten all 6mm hardware with 6-7 ft-lbs torque and 8mm hardware with 16-18 ft-lbs torque.

STEP 7: The Other Side Step Bar Installation

Repeat Steps 1-6 for the Other Side Step Bar Installation.
And then installation is completed!!!

Attention

Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.
In order to protect your bars/boards, please use mild soap/non-abrasive products for cleaning only.
