

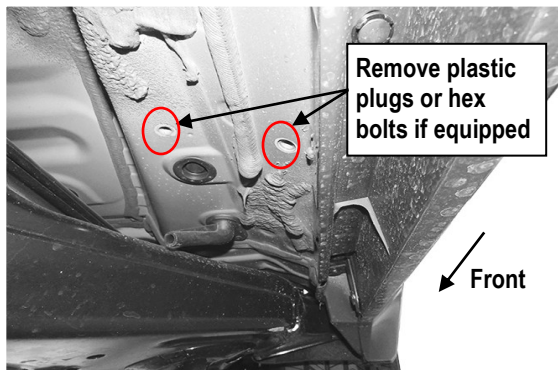

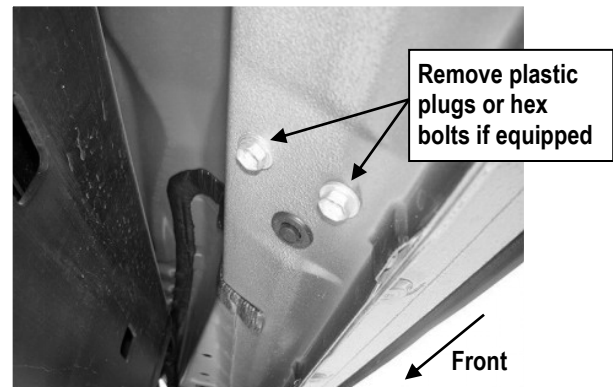


## STEP 1: Locate Passenger Side Mounting Positions

- Locate the mounting positions along the inner side of the body panel on the passenger side the vehicle (**Figs 1-2**).
- Remove the plastic plugs or hex bolts covering the (2) threaded holes in the body panel if equipped.



(Fig 1) Passenger Side Front Mounting Position



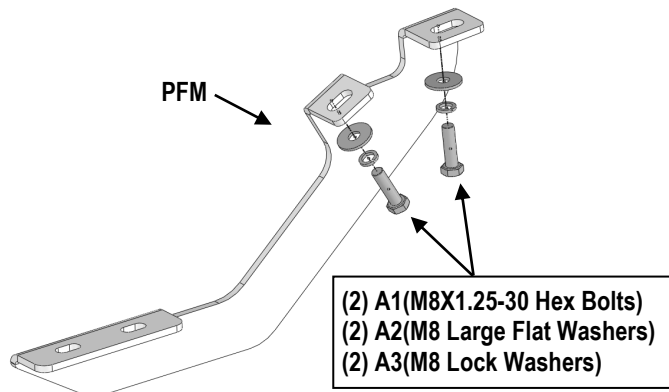
(Fig 2) Typical Passenger Side Center/ Rear Mounting Position

## STEP 2: Install Passenger Front Mounting Bracket

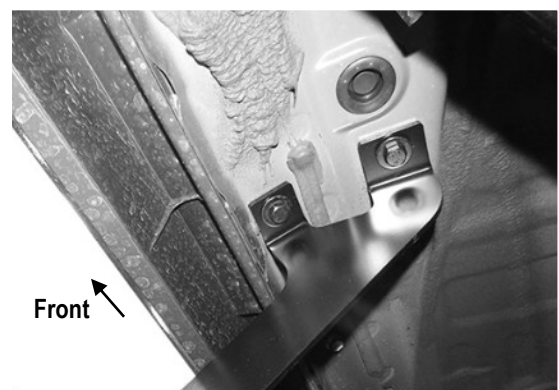

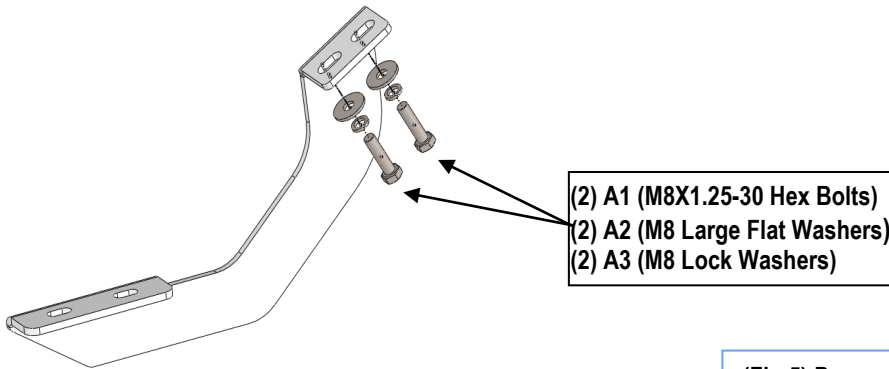
(Fig 4) Passenger Front Mounting Bracket Installed

Attach the Passenger Front Mounting Bracket (**PFM**) to the Passenger Front Mounting Location (**Figs 1,3,4**) with :

- (2) A1 (M8X1.25-30 Hex Bolts)
- (2) A2 (M8 Large Flat Washers)
- (2) A3 (M8 Lock Washers)

**Note: Do not fully tighten at this time.**



(Fig 3) Passenger Front Mounting Bracket Installation

### STEP 3: Install Passenger Center & Rear Mounting Brackets

Repeat **Step 2** to install the (3) Passenger Center & Rear Mounting Brackets (**PRM**) to Passenger Side Center & Rear Mounting Positions (**Figs 2&5**).

**Note:** Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

### STEP 4: Passenger Side Running Board Installation

Once all (4) mounting brackets are installed, then proceed to the Running Board installation.

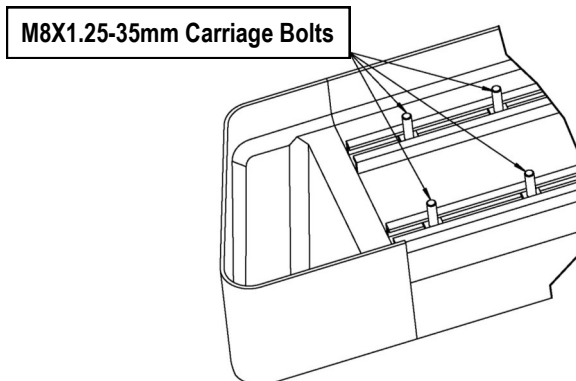
(1) Select a Running Board. Slide (4) B1 (M8X1.25-35mm Carriage Bolts) into each bottom channel (**Fig 6**).

(2) Carefully position the Running Board onto the (4) Mounting Brackets.

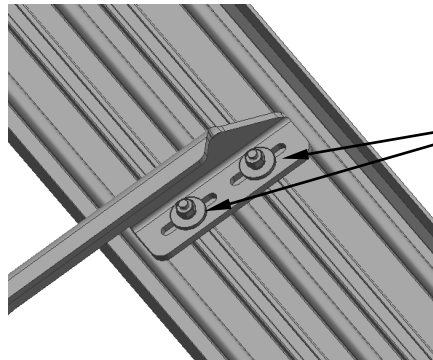
(3) Attach the Running Board to each Mounting Bracket (**Fig 7**) with

- (2) B1 (M8X1.25-35mm Carriage Bolts)
- (2) B2 (M8 Large Flat Washers)
- (2) B3 (M8 Nylon Lock Nuts)

**Note:** Do not slide the Running Board on the Brackets or the bottom surface of the board will be damaged.

(2) B1 (M8X1.25-35mm Carriage Bolts)  
(2) B2 (M8 Large Flat Washers)  
(2) B3 (M8 Nylon Lock Nuts)

## STEP 5: Passenger Side Running Board Adjustment

- Level and adjust the Running Board properly.
- Tighten all 8mm hardware with 16-18 ft-lbs torque.

## STEP 6: The Other Side Running Board Installation

Repeat Steps 1-5 for the Other Side Running Board Installation.

And then installation is completed!!!

### Attention

Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.  
In order to protect your bars/boards, please use mild soap/non-abrasive products for cleaning only.
